- Aim is to foster strategic Collaboration for Professional Excellence
- Approved by the ECSA Health Ministers Conference held from 7th-11th November 1988. Resolutions discussed by the Ministers
- Launched in Malawi in 1990





Objectives of ECSACONM

- Promote regional collaboration and networking
- Speak authoritatively on nursing and midwifery in the region
- Provide leadership to nurses and midwives in ECSA Region
- Strengthen professional regulation
- Provide forums for sharing experiences and lessons learnt
- Establish minimum standards for nursing and midwifery education & practice within ECSA Region



Governance Structure

- The structure consists of a general assembly (entire membership) and the Council of National Representatives (CNRs)
- The **CNR** is the functional organ of the college through which its policies and decisions are made
- Each country has a National Chapter with an inclusive Executive Committee and functional faculties
- Elections are held every 4 years (Next Election 2026)


